

## PRELIMINARY ACQUISITION NOTICE

The City of Thompson is applying for a \$450,000 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) to help homeowners that qualify to pay the property assessments associated with connecting their property to the City's wastewater collection system in Phase 3 and Phase 4 of the project. To make the improvements, which involve the abandonment of individual septic systems and the connection of homes to the City's collection system, a homeowner must allow a temporary construction easement to allow a contractor to work on their property. The estimated cost of abandoning septic and connecting a home to the City's system is approximately \$5,400. If the CDBG funds are awarded to the City, it will use the grant to pay the assessments for qualifying low-and-moderate income homeowners. Connecting your home to the City's system is voluntary.
